

Internet Security Update - **RANSOMWARE**



As noted in this month's edition of the FDM4 Insight, the FBI has recently released a statement that the incidents of Ransomware are on the rise:

Due to a high level of interest, FDM4 has developed a service to assist in protecting your environment, working to reduce the risk of a Ransomware attack. While this service does involve an extensive look into your FDM4 environment configuration – we are offering a fixed service fee for **WMS Environment** - 8 hours at \$1,160 & **ERP Environment** - 16 hours at \$2,320.

1. Define your existing samba shares, and Unix directory structure.
2. Confirm all FDM4 databases are not part of any share; if they are, change them.
3. Redesign the shares, as necessary, to run the FDM4 application.
4. Implement new design /map on test, record any changes and downtime required.
5. Implement on live.

While this alone does not stop your environment from being compromised, it does provide another level of security and assurance based on the last documented attack methods of ransomware.
